



Two-Piece Shuffleboard Disclosure & Release

Dear Customer,

Split (two-piece) shuffleboard playfields are necessary for some installations due to site conditions. However, they increase the potential for future maintenance issues and require a higher degree of installation proficiency.

We manufacture split two-piece shuffleboard playfields by cutting a fully completed playfield in two and sealing the cut ends. Once cut, the two halves may potentially acclimate to temperature and humidity at different rates, potentially creating an uneven surface. This is solved by a combination of shims and adjustment of the climate adjusters underneath the top to bring the two halves into alignment.

During installation, our designated installer will:

1. Make sure the cradle is level and flat before dropping in the board.
2. Make sure the board is flat across the middle seam after lowering into place and shim if necessary.
3. Carefully clamp the two sides of the board together before tightening the joining bolts under the board.
4. Adjust the climate adjusters so the ends come together.

Jack Game Room will assume responsibility for ensuring a split two-piece shuffleboard is properly installed. Jack Game Room cannot assume responsibility for ensuring a split two-piece shuffleboard remains level and aligned post-installation. It is the responsibility of the table owner to monitor and maintain the playability of the table over time as the playfield adjusts to its environment. This may require engaging a professional installer to return in the future to level, align and fine-tune the two surfaces.
